Costume Workshop

In this hands-on class, students explore the role of the costume designer in stage and screen. Students receive practical instruction in costume building as well as design instruction including the way color, fabric and style define character and assist in storytelling.

Critiquing Theatre

Training and practice in the craft of writing theatrical reviews. Attention to the roles and responsibilities of the critic and all aspects of writing effective reviews.

Introduction to Tech Theater

Students develop valuable backstage theater training in this hands-on class. Students gain appreciation and technical skills through exploring elements of scenic construction, scenic painting, lighting, sound, props, costumes, make-up and special effects.
